Wow! I give many thanks for all the Trinity family did to mark my 15<sup>th</sup> anniversary of ordination to the Priesthood. Gail X2 gave us a truly wonderful performance with piano and organ duets and 4 hands on the piano! It has truly been a blessing to serve this community for all these years and I look forward to continuing the journey with you as we live into our calling as a faith community. I just love the portable communion kit – it is simply beautiful – and will be used and treasured by me for the rest of my life.

Last month I shared thoughts about this amazing congregation called Episcopal Church of the Trinity and that our anniversary year is truly one worth celebrating. Share your light! We have received wonderful news regarding grants to assist us in maintaining our buildings. The Diocesan Growth Development Fund is granting us \$30,000 to purchase a new stove/oven and to replace our exhaust/ventilation system which needs to be brought up to current code. We have received word from the Stewart Huston Charitable Trust that we will receive \$15,000 toward water infiltration issues – i.e. the columbarium to the extent it corrects water in the hall basement, the roof repair on Stone Hall and the sanctuary's Stone mortar repair. We have also received \$10,000 from the Society for the Advancement of Christianity toward the Sanctuary's stone mortar repair. We are truly blessed with many partners in faith in our wider community. We give great thanks for their contribution to our mission and ministry. We give great thanks for their mission and ministry! We are on this journey together.

Remember, as we celebrate 150 Years of Faith in Coatesville, we are taking this unique opportunity to share our light with many others, far and wide. #### St. Cyril's Day

St. Cyril's Day falls on Sunday, June 24<sup>th</sup> this year and we will have a special musical performance by Concordia Choral Arts at 3 p.m. in celebration of this special day that marks Cyril as our Patron Saint and remembers the importance and existence of the St. Cyril's Episcopal Church in Coatesville prior to the merger with Trinity. After the performance, we will have a special reception at Graystone Mansion, just down a couple blocks at First Avenue and Harmony Street. Abram Francis Huston, who succeeded his father, Dr. Charles Huston, as president of Lukens Iron and Steel Company in 1897, built Graystone Mansion in 1889 and lived there until his death in 1930. Sold to the City of Coatesville in 1938, Graystone served as City Hall until 1992. Philadelphia architects Cope & Stewardson designed Graystone employing Collegiate Gothic styling, which the firm initiated and used on several college campuses.

It is a magnificent building, and our reception gives a wonderful opportunity to see the Mansion up close and personal. Join us for a celebratory day!
