From the Rector's Desk . . .

Several people have asked about the Thistle Farms Conference in Nashville that Deacon Joan, Jennifer Lopez and I attended to learn more about beginning a sister ministry here in Coatesville. In short, it was AMAZING! We attended the pre-conference session on "Digging Deep: Sharing Residential Experiences" in which good, practical information was shared about the specifics of the Thistle Farms residential program. We heard from the United States Ambassador, John Richmond, about trafficking in the U.S. We attended breakout sessions on Trauma Informed Care; Keys to Launching the Enterprise; From Strategic Planning to Strategic Thinking and Fearless Fundraising.

One of the most powerful sessions was the Survivor Leaders Conversation (Help, Hope and Healing) in which we were able to "sit in" on a group session with five Survivors. They told their stories and I was struck by one of the commonalities. All but one of the women experienced sexual abuse by someone they knew, family members, when they were very young. It was a gift to all of us who were present at the conference for these women to tell such deeply personal stories of just how they wound up in the world of sex trafficking. I am deeply grateful that Trinity is supporting a ministry that will work to enable women involved in this world to find a different way to live their life; to reclaim their lives. Love heals.

We also enjoyed meeting and connecting with others, all over the country (and world!), who are involved in this movement. And, we discovered that when you are in Nashville, you will most definitely see and hear from people who have a guitar and a wonderful voice. Music was everywhere.

Thistle Hills (the name of our Coatesville sister program) has received its first grant of \$7,500 from the Stewart Huston Charitable Trust. We have applied for a grant to purchase and renovate a home that we have identified near the church. We won't hear about that until the fall. In the meantime, the board /mission committee is forming and we will begin work on fund raising and brainstorming the social enterprise piece, etc.

Direction and map on the other side



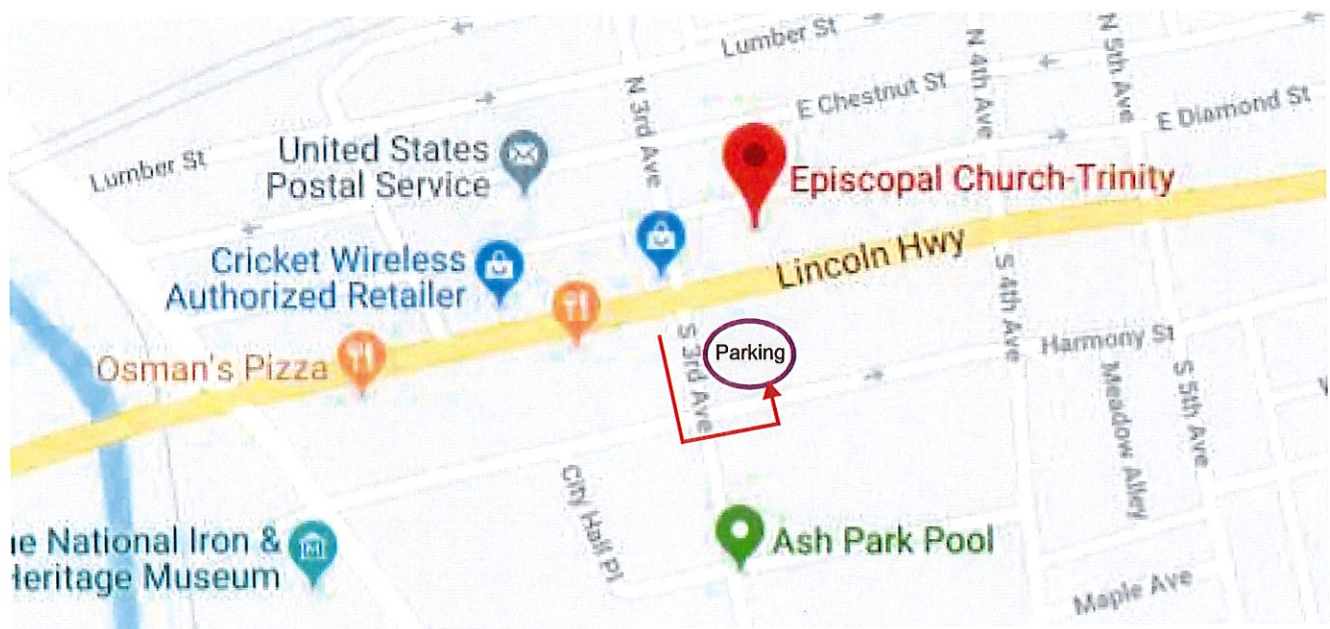

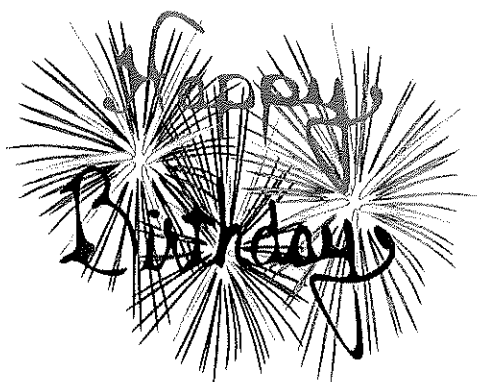
