## The Great Thanksgiving

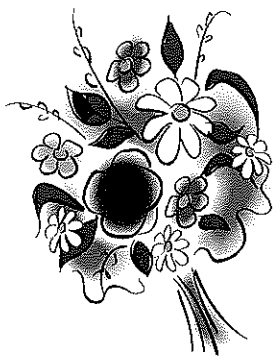
