From the Rector's Desk . . .

Dear Friends,

As Easter comes once again for us and we ring out loud Alleluias(!) in remembrance of Jesus' glorious resurrection, I believe we are all still a bit weary from a long pandemic and all the aftermath. It is a very present reminder that good and bad, light and dark, are interwoven in our life on this earth. As Christians we strive to live our lives doing good and being good. We are searching for the divine, for the light. Becca Stevens, of Thistle Farms, has something to say about this in her latest book, *Practically Divine*. She writes:

"It doesn't matter where we are—whether we are reading this in the comfort of our bed, on a prison cot, or wandering in the world—something divine is present at any given moment.
