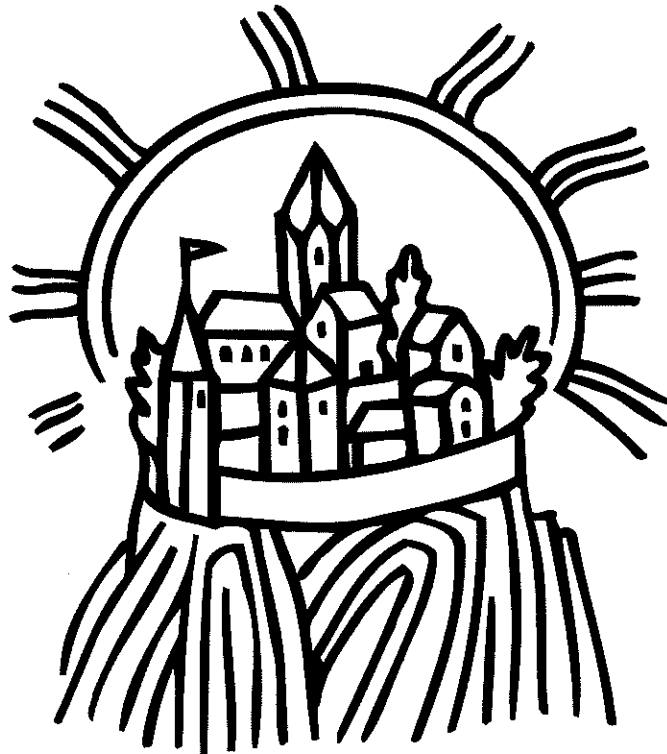

THE SERMON BY THE REV. SHERRY DEETS

THE CREED

All stand.

We acknowledge one baptism for the forgiveness of sins. We look for the resurrection of the dead, and the life of the world to come. Amen.

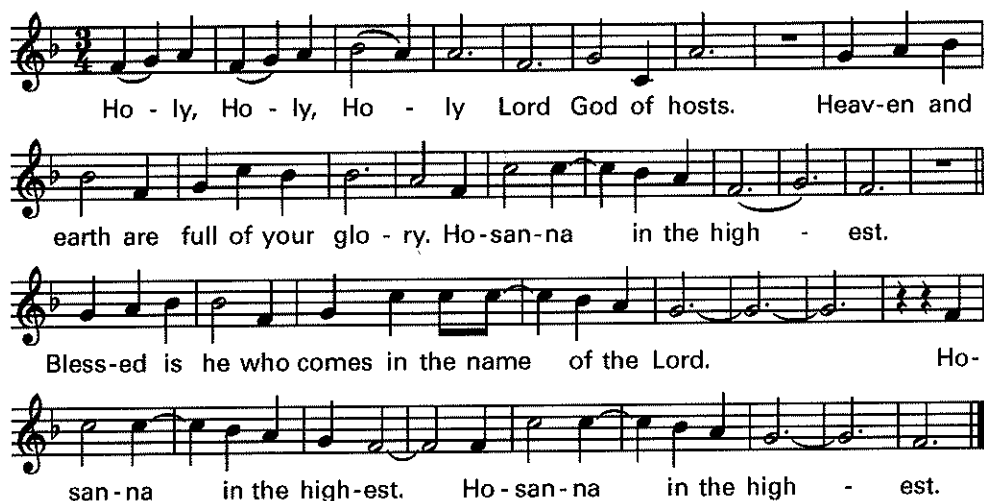

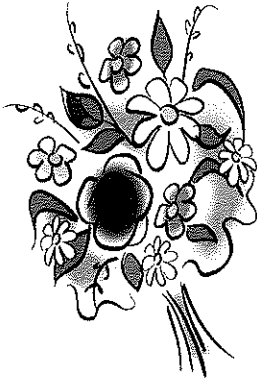
