The crisp winter chill is in the air and there is a certain electricity in the air this Advent season. I think it's related to anticipation. We were able to gather with others for Thanksgiving and anticipate gathering for Christmas, as we are able after the last two years were greatly affected by the pandemic. This Advent season I am reminded repeatedly of what it means to be grateful and that it often takes intentionality. By intentionality, I mean setting aside some time each day, either in the morning or evening before bed, so review something that I am grateful for. This practice, done on a regular basis, has been shown to make a difference.

I share from the book, *Find Your Way: 20 Practices That Tie Us Together,* Naomi Hagan's words on Gratitude. Naomi is a graduate of Oasis of Northwest Arkansas, a sister organization of Thistle Farms.

I had to "Live in Gratitude". Leaving behind the judgment of others. Accepting the crosses, I have to bear. Realizing I am who I was created to be, instead of trying to find who I should become, set me free. I found humility in gratitude. I found grace and I found mercy. Gratitude is an action. You take care of what you're grateful for. When I say, "I'm grateful for my recovery," you'll see me go to meetings with a sponsor. I take action in my recovery. When I say, "I'm grateful for my home," you'll see me cleaning my house, tending to the yard, making my bed. Taking care of what you're grateful for—my thankful words turned into grateful actions.
